1. Robert Cooper, 3529 CR 1250: Owner of the Longfellow School and the nonprofit Friend & Kin Properties, Inc. He requested that the park planned for the area near the old school not be abandoned. He stated that K-FAN uses part of the building and currently serves between 200 and 300 families per month, children must sit and wait while parent's complete paperwork. They also plan to add temporary/transitioning housing for individuals and families. This would not be free housing residents would be required to pay what they can or contribute labor. Plans include four two-bedroom apartments and one four-bedroom apartment. He also plans to convert eight classrooms back into classroom space for programs such as English as a Second Language (ESL), GED training, and after-school tutoring. There will also be space available for other nonprofits to rent.

Frankie Hull: If it had to be down sized what is your vision?

Robert Cooper: A play structure with a swing set, a soccer goal, walking path, picnic tables and a basketball hoop. He would also like a fence to be put up to keep the kids from running out in to the street.
